Hello again everyone. I thought in view of the last year's eventful ending and my plans for this year it would be appropriate to circulate the Spring Newsletter earlier rather than later.

2017 was a successful year with the sales at the three main shows I exhibited at being up on the previous twelve months. Commission work increased which was very pleasing and I had also had some success in entering/submitting work into individual exhibitions.

As many of you will know the year ended on a high note for me with the award of a residency at the much respected 18th Street Arts Centre in Santa Monica, California. Together with Anne I had the privilege of being at the Centre for the whole of December.

I soon realised that I was not going to be able to produce much actual work whilst in Santa Monica because of the need to research the area with regard to my subject matter. Also I spent quite an amount of time meeting curators, visiting museums and making contact with local galleries and their owners. As a result of this I now feel that I am in a position to move forward producing a body of work that will have continuity and substance.

At this point in time I have decided that my overall theme will be 'disappearing space' as coined by the famous architect John Lautner who was very influential in the early Modernist Movement in California. Along with this theme I will be concentrating on what is often referred to in architectural terms as LA Modern and Desert Modern. I would hope that within six months I will have at least half a dozen new pieces of work ready for exhibition and which I will post on my website (tonymossfineart.co.uk) as I go along. In the meantime see the two examples below.
